The 7000 series consists of high end Ultrabook computers, introduced in 2014 with the Latitude E7440 and E7240. The Education series laptops are designed for use in educational institutions. They're not especially powerful, and are more geared towards office applications or internet based applications. The Rugged series laptops are similar to the previous Latitude XFR computers. They are designed with extra durability in mind.

Both have support for an optional internal Bluetooth module, a socket for an optional mobile broadband card, and have an external switch for disabling any wireless connections. It had a PATA hard drive and a D-series modular bay, and used an ATI Radeon 9000 GPU. Unlike later D6x0 series machines, both memory sockets were accessible from a single cover on the bottom of the system.
